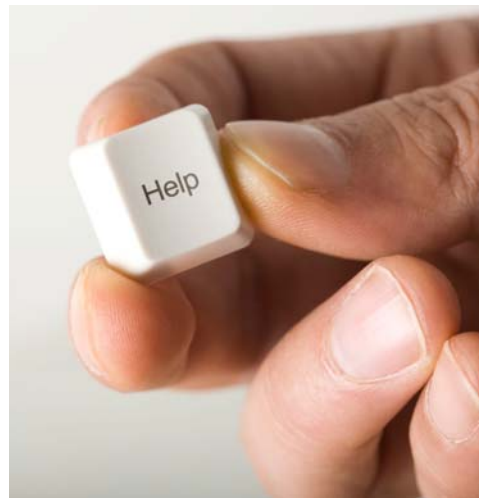

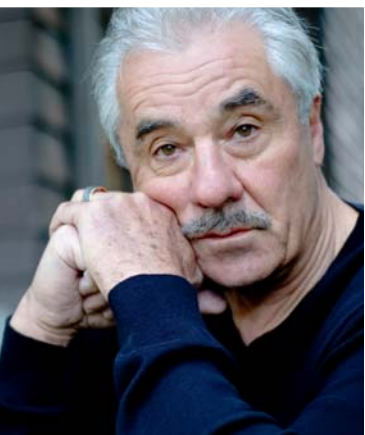

Individual, Couples and Family Counseling

Recognizing the importance of relationships, our therapists work with individuals, couples and families to foster personal growth and stability. We engage in a holistic approach which means we seek solutions for the whole person and harmony in relationships.

Alcohol & Other Drug Addictions (AODA) Counseling

Our credentialed AODA professionals bring an empathetic and non-judgmental approach to assisting people with their recovery. Both individual and group therapy are utilized to assist individuals and families affected by substance abuse. We are an approved Driver Safety Plan Provider for persons with Driving Under the Influence (DUI) convictions.

Group Counseling

Group counseling can offer natural supports to people seeking solutions to their issues. Commonly held groups include: AODA recovery, relationships, emotional/stress management, parenting, anger management and domestic violence. Our professionals are well trained and experienced in group counseling techniques, which is important for the facilitation of a successful group experience.

In-Home Family Therapy

Recognizing the importance of the cohesion of a family, our professionals work with families in their homes to foster new ways of relating and interacting with each other and build family strength. Our therapists can help families heal from crisis, strengthen their connections, and learn new skills and processes to promote healthy productive living and greater overall family stability.

Employee Assistance Programs (EAP)

ACC is a provider of Employee Assistance Programs for several professional businesses. These programs focus on a broad range of employee needs, including work and personal areas, wellness presentations, newsletters, and other identified services with the overall goal of employees and companies being more productive.

Single Interview Screens for Step-Parent Adoption

Our staff are trained in the completion of court ordered adoption screenings which are required by the state of Wisconsin. Most frequently, this process is completed via a number of home visits which allow our therapist to meet the family in their home.

Mediation Services

Mediation services are available for individuals experiencing conflict and seeking an alternative to litigation. Mediation is a cooperative process of problem solving where a neutral party assists in clarifying issues and finding "win/win" solutions that are in the best interest of both concerned parties. Our skilled mediators are often used during divorce particularly in considering the best interests of the children.

Correctional Services

On a county specific contractual basis, ACC provides a broad range of services to area law enforcement agencies. Services may include, but are not limited to: emergency mental health assessments, psychiatric assessment and monitoring, anger management and AODA educational groups, AODA and risk assessments.

Crisis Phone Line / Chapter 34 Services

On a county specific contractual basis, ACC has experience providing emergency on-call services, mobile crisis intervention, crisis stabilization, linkage and referral services, and related services which are provided for as established by Wisconsin State Statutes (Ch. 34). Our experience level, community connectedness and responsiveness assist us to provide exceptional support to community members in the counties we serve.

Community Support Program (CSP)

On a county specific contractual basis, we also have experience providing Community Support Program (CSP) services to assist individuals with chronic and persistent mental illness.
