- Implement a Plan of Care with input from the individual/family to meet goals.
- Create an Emergency Plan to address individual's safety in a crisis or natural disaster.
- Advocate for individuals receiving care to insure his/her integrity has not been compromised.

Age of Tomorrow will provide senior individuals with assistance to maintain their independence while allowing their adult children the security of knowing someone is there to help. Contact Aurora Community Health, Inc. if you have concerns about you or a parent with:

- Living in an environment which may be unsafe
- Falling or tripping
- Coordinating doctor appointments, understanding diagnosis, treatments, post hospitalization care or correctly managing their medications
- Having chronic or progressive illnesses
- Not eating or taking part in day to day activities or personal care needs
- Experiencing mood changes
- Driving, finding rides
- Being isolated from friends, neighbors or family
