- Physician Ordered Services

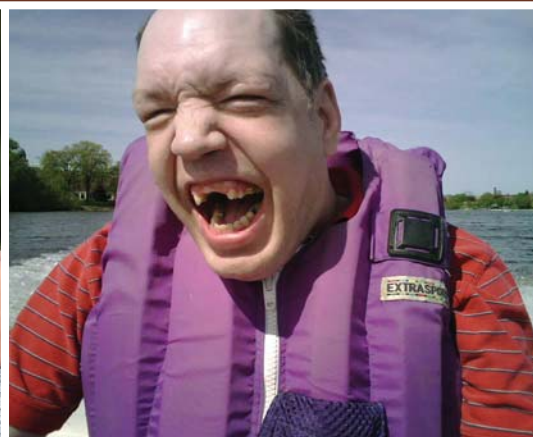

Skilled Nursing Visits

A Skilled Nursing Visit is conducted by one of Aurora's Registered Nurses as ordered by your physician. Nursing visits may include, but are not limited to, vital checks, coaching on healthcare or healthcare topics, or assistance with medications.

Medical Assistance Personal Care

Medical Assistance Personal Care (MAPC) is a state and federally funded program, designed to provide individuals with services which allow them to live in their own home and function as independently as possible. Persons who receive Medical Assistance, (Medicaid) and who qualify for assistance with personal cares are eligible for this service. Personal care is provided by a personal care worker who is supervised by a registered nurse. ACH provides supervisory visits under contract to agencies that operate an MAPC program. Personal care includes assistance with bathing, dressing, feeding, grooming, mobility, toileting and medically oriented tasks which in certain situations do not require the direct services of a nurse.

Home Health Aide Services

A Home Health Aide can be used for medically oriented tasks such as checking blood pressures, assisting with personal cares and limited household tasks under the supervision of a registered nurse. These tasks are also specifically ordered by your physician.
